- Share photos you've taken that inspire your work

Answer common questions about your blog, business, or products

- Put together a "getting started" guide
- Show how your blog or products differ from others
- Share info about the charity organisations you support
- Do an "ask the readers" roundup
- > Point out the difference between two similar products you sell
- Show some ways to use your product
- Create an FAQ post
- Create a SAQ post (questions your readers SHOULD ask, but don't)

Share what you've learned along the way

- Share struggles you've had with your business, and how you overcome them
- Share what you've learned about people
- Share what you learned about yourself
- Create a research post that dives deep into a topic and shares what you've discovered

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Share an income report post, with details on how you earned your income.

Give advice

- Write a post with tips popular show
- > Write a post on how to prepare for an interview or appearance
- Write a post on how to save money on something
- Create an "ultimate guide" post with in depth info on a given topic

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> Write a post that helps people be more successful with any product

Interview yourself

- > What do you wish people would ask you/ format it as a Q&A on your blog
- > Be open to interviews, and ask if you can share them on your blog as well
- > Be an authority by interviewing others about insider details of your industry

Give your opinion on a hot topic in your industry

- > Share your stance on an issue that people are divided on
- > Explain an unpopular opinion of yours, and why you feel that way
- Sive a comprehensive explanation of something new in your industry.
- Introduce people to a new method
- Review books about your field
- > Test two methods and report your findings
- Write a "what if" post on a topic

Roundups

- > Do a blog post roundups
- > Do a quote roundup of your favourite quotes
- > Do a random of cool or pretty instagram photos
- > Do a roundup of your favourite artists
- > Do a roundup of your favourite stores or gift shops
- Do a roundup of your best posts

Interview other people

- Interview someone who makes a product that complements your blog
- > Interview someone in your field that you admire
- Interview other small businesses that you think your customers would like
- Interview a controversial face in your field
- > Write a profile of a prominent figure in your field
- Ask the same question of several people and create a post of the various answers

Ask a question & start a discussion

- Ask for opinions on new product ideas
- > Ask for opinions on color choices for a new line
- > Ask readers what they'd like help with
- > Ask readers how they use your blog or products
- Ask readers what they wish you'd make
- Let people vote on a product name

Feature your readers & customers

Show photos of customers using your products, recipes, or DIY ideas

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Share how readers are using your products

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- > Interview your readers to see how your ideas are making their lives easier
- > Feature interesting readers to make it clear what you niche is
- Showcase things your customers have made with your products
- > Have a hashtag that your customers can use to be featured
- > Request customer photos and info as part of a contest

Miscellaneous

- > Do a pick of the week post featuring your favourite content, tool, or resource
- Write an off-topic post-something you don't normally write about, just to see how your audience responds

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- > Create a challenge for your readers (this can be a good series)
- Create a post to host a contest
- Create a video post
